Apricot	<i>Prunus ameniaca</i>	stem, bark, seed pits
Azalea	<i>Rhododendron occidentale</i>	all parts
Baneberry	<i>Actaea Spicata</i>	berries, roots, foliage
Buchberry	<i>Lantana</i>	all parts
Castor Bean	<i>Rincinus communis</i>	seeds, if chewed
Choke Cherry	<i>Pruuns virginica</i>	leaves, seed pits, stems, bark
Daffodil	<i>Narcissus</i>	bulbs
Daphne	<i>Daphne mexereum</i>	berries, bark, leaves
Foxglove	<i>Digitalis purpura</i>	leaves, seeds, flowers
Hemlock	<i>Conium maculatum</i>	all parts, root and root stalk
Hens-and-Chicks	<i>Lantana</i>	all parts
Hyacinth	<i>Hyacinthus orientalis</i>	bulbs, leaves, flowers
Hydrangea	<i>Hydrangea macrophylla</i>	leaves, bulbs
Jerusalem Cherry	<i>Solanum pseudocapsicum</i>	All parts, unripe foot
Jimson Weed	<i>Datura stramonium</i>	all parts
Jonquil	<i>Narcissus</i>	bulbs
Lily of the Valley	<i>Convallaria majalis</i>	all parts
Mandrake	<i>Podophyllum peltatum</i>	root, foliage, unripe fruit
Mistletoe	<i>Phoradendron Flavescens</i>	berries
Morning Glory	<i>Ipomoea violaces</i>	seeds
Nightshade	<i>Atropa belladonna</i>	all parts
Oleander	<i>Norium Oleander</i>	all parts including dried leaves
Poinsettia	<i>Euphorbia pulcherrima</i>	leaves, flowers
Pokeweed, inkberry	<i>Phytolacca americana</i>	all parts
Red Sage	<i>Lantana camara</i>	green berries
Rhododendron	<i>Rhododendron</i>	all parts
Rhubarb	<i>Rheum raponticum</i>	leaves
Sweet Pea	<i>Lathyrus odoratus</i>	seed and pods
Tulip	<i>Tulipa</i>	bulbs
Wisteria	<i>Wisteria</i>	seeds and pods
Yew	<i>Taxus</i>	Needles, bark, seeds
